

Your privacy is critically important to us. At Tapaygo, we have a few fundamental principles: We don't ask you for personal information unless we truly need it to identify you as a user and secure your access to the services we provide. We don't share your personal information with anyone and without your permission except to comply with the law, develop our products, provide our services, or protect our rights. In our products, we aim to make it as simple as possible for you to control what's publicly available, seen by search engines, kept private, and permanently deleted. It is Tapaygo's policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect while operating our websites.

Website visitors Like many website operators, Tapaygo collects non-personally-identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request. Tapaygo's purpose in collecting non-personally identifying information is to better understand how visitors use its website. From time to time, Tapaygo may release non-personally-identifying information in the aggregate, e.g., by publishing a report on trends in the usage of its website. Tapaygo also collects potentially personally-identifying information like Internet Protocol (IP) addresses for logged in users and for users publishing information on Tapaygo.com. Tapaygo only discloses logged in user information under the same circumstances that it uses and discloses personally-identifying information as described below, except that more detailed user information is visible and disclosed to the administrators of Tapaygo and the organizers of events for which tickets were purchased as described below.

Gathering of personal identifying information Certain visitors to Tapaygo.com choose to interact with Tapaygo or event organizers in ways that require Tapaygo to gather personally-identifying information. The amount and type of information that Tapaygo gathers depends on the nature of the interaction. For example, we ask visitors who sign up for an account on Tapaygo.com to provide a username, full name, password, country and city of residence and email address. Those who engage in transactions – for example, buying or selling a ticket with Tapaygo – are asked to provide additional information, including, as necessary, the personal and financial information required to process those transactions. In each case, Tapaygo collects such information only insofar as is necessary or appropriate to fulfill the purpose of the user's interaction with Tapaygo and event organizers. Tapaygo does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below.

Visitors can always refuse to supply personally-identifying information, with the caveat that it may prevent them from engaging in certain website-related activities. **Aggregated statistics** Tapaygo may collect statistics about the behavior of visitors to its websites. For instance, Tapaygo may monitor the most popular events on the Tapaygo.com site. Tapaygo may display this information publicly or provide it to others. However, Tapaygo does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below.

Protection of certain personal identifying information Tapaygo discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only to those of its employees, contractors, event organizers and affiliated organizations that (i) need to know that information in order to process it on Tapaygo's behalf or to provide services available on Tapaygo.com, and (ii) that have agreed not to disclose it to others. Some of those employees, contractors, event organizers and affiliated organizations may be located outside of your home country; by using Tapaygo.com, you consent to the transfer of such information to them. Tapaygo will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone. Other than to its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations, as described above, Tapaygo discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only in response to a

subpoena, court order or other governmental request, or when Tapaygo believes in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of Tapaygo, third parties or the public at large. If you are a registered user of Tapaygo.com and have supplied your email address, Tapaygo may occasionally send you an email to tell you about new features, solicit your feedback, or just keep you up to date with what's going on with Tapaygo, our products and services. We primarily use our various product blogs to communicate this type of information, so we expect to keep this type of email to a minimum. If you send us a request (for example via a support email or via one of our feedback mechanisms), we reserve the right to publish it in order to help us clarify or respond to your request or to help us support other users. Tapaygo takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information. If you are a registered user of Tapaygo.com, have supplied your email address and have provided permission for an event organizer to contact you about future events, these event organizers may occasionally contact you through the Tapaygo platform to update you about events you registered to or purchased ticket to, or to inform you about upcoming events. Event organizers who have not requested your email address can only contact you through the Tapaygo platform. You can always revoke an event organizer's permission to contact you. Cookies A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. Tapaygo uses cookies to help identify and track visitors, their usage of Tapaygo.com, and their website access preferences. Tapaygo visitors who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using Tapaygo.com, with the drawback that certain features of Tapaygo.com may not function properly without the aid of cookies. Business transfers If Tapaygo, or substantially all of its assets, were acquired, or in the unlikely event that Tapaygo goes out of business or enters bankruptcy, user information would be one of the assets that is transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur, and that any acquirer of Tapaygo may continue to use your personal information as set forth in this policy.
